Innovation Brew Works Wins Big at San Diego International Beer Competition and Los Angeles International Beer Competition

Innovation Brew Works (IBW) at Cal Poly Pomona brought home big wins at both the San Diego International Beer Competition and the Los Angeles International Beer Competition this past month.

Innovation Brew Works received a gold medal for their Hybrid Belgian-Style Ale called Cattle Rancher at the 2018 San Diego International Beer Competition. They also took home two bronze medals for their New World Bavarian Rye and Brethren Belgian.

IBW also participated in the 2018 Los Angeles International Beer Competition where they received a silver medal for their Cattle Rancher.

Both competitions are highly competitive in the brewing industry and recognize only the finest beers. The San Diego International Beer Competition featured over 1,500 entries with participation from more than 250 breweries nationwide.

The talented brewers and staff at Innovation Brew Works are thrilled about this accomplishment and are looking forward to many more. "Winning these medals at these prestigious events places Innovation Brew Works amongst the finest breweries in the world today," says Aaron Neilson, Cal Poly Pomona Foundation Dining Services Director.
